Emtro/T Records announces date of “LIVE” recording for Arkansas Gospel Mass Choir’s sophomore project

ROGERS, ARKANSAS, June 14, 2010 – Emtro/T Records invites the Northwest Arkansas community to the 2nd Live Recording of the Arkansas Gospel Mass Choir (AGMC). The choir that brought you “Hold on for Life” with the single release and top 5 R&R Charts single “I lift My Hands” is gearing up for this spectacular event. The live recording will take place on Saturday, July 31, 2010 at 5 p.m. at the Rogers First Church of the Nazarene, 4911 W Pleasant Grove Road in Rogers, AR.
